- Assist Waste Diversion Supervisor, Manager, and staff with other waste diversion projects (e.g. special events, audits) as needed
- Be instrumental in supporting the launch of the first Green Bin (food and organic waste) program for the Essex-Windsor region as required

- The ideal candidate should have a positive attitude and be eager to gain valuable experience with a reputable public sector employer while contributing to the launch of a new regional Waste Diversion program.
- Able to perform physical work outdoors in all weather conditions
- Mechanical skills and experience with routine maintenance is considered an asset

- Must possess and maintain a valid Class "G" Ontario driver's license
- Must provide a Ministry of Transportation Driver Abstract (Uncertified)
- Must be returning to full-time studies in September 2025
